# What We Do

## Adopt a Kid/Adopt a Vet

This popular program involves grade school children grades 4 thru 6. The program is held twice a year, usually around Memorial Day in the Spring and Veterans Day in the Fall. Vets meet with a small group of children and talk about their military experi-



ences of interest to the group. The vets return to the school about a month later

when schools usually make the return visit an assembly for the entire student body.

## Parade Support

Chapter members participate in and support local community parades with a military presence. The chapter has supported the American Spirit Parade and the Millersville Community Parade.



## ROTC Support

The Lancaster Chapter supports the Army ROTC Detachment at Millersville University. The chapter provides some funding for projects and equipment needed by cadets not covered by the Army or university.



A MOAA leadership award and a modest monetary award are presented to two outstanding cadets annually. Chapter members also attend events sponsored by the detachment as speakers or presenters.

## JROTC Support

The Chapter supports Air Force JROTC cadets at Muhlenberg H.S., Army JROTC cadets at Lebanon H.S., and Navy JROTC cadets at Elizabethtown H.S. by supporting one week STEAM summer camps.

## Speaker Bureau

Drawing from a large membership, the chapter has a wide range of member expertise and experiences to draw from in providing speakers to local clubs and civic organizations. Chapter speakers are most active at Memorial Day and Veterans Day events in the community.

## Chapter Meetings

Chapter members and their spouses enjoy attending two dinner meetings, two luncheon meetings and an early December Christmas dinner meeting. The chapter meets at exceptional places such as private country clubs, private golf clubs, resort hotels and fine dining restaurants.
