- **Smoking & Lung Cancer Screening:**

Dave Lawrence, M.D., CAPT, Medical Corp, USN (Ret), who is a chapter member and a director on our board of directors, discussed this topic at the last board meeting. The board was supportive in getting this word out and suggested it be published in the November newsletter. His discussion follows:

"Many veterans have smoked and may be at risk for lung cancer. Most lung cancers are identified at an advanced stage with a very poor survival rate. A National Screening Trial of 53,000 patients was performed in an attempt to identify lung cancers at an early stage. Low dose CAT Scan of the chest was performed annually with the results showing a 20% decrease in lung cancer mortality.



● **Smoking & Lung Cancer Screening:** (cont'd)

The current screening criteria are:

No symptoms or signs of lung cancer (you are asymptomatic)

50-80 years of age, (Medicare covers up to 77 years of age)

20 pack year smoking history,

Current or previous smoker who has quit in the last 15years.

Consider discussing your smoking history with your Primary Care provider to see if Lung Cancer screening might be appropriate for you. Coverage for the CAT scan will vary depending on your insurance."
