luncheon on Sunday, December 7 at Millersville University. The event falls on a date that our country will never forget and will be an opportunity for you to gather with those who are serving or have served our country. Details for the luncheon are contained in this newsletter.

The chapter has many outreach projects that we have engaged in over the past several years and is currently exploring additional opportunities. One of these new programs is a financial award to a JROTC cadet who has enlisted in the military prior to high school graduation.
